Instructions

Number of players

2

Setup

Print out the 12 cards on thick card stock (to prevent show through). Use a printer that can print two-sided (or just feed the paper through twice) and print both the front and back sides. Cut out all 12 cards. Shuffle them and then lay them face down in a 4 by 3 grid.

Object

Find the most pairs of matching cards, matching the vocabulary word with the definition.

How to play

The first player turns over two cards. If the two cards match, the player takes the cards and takes another turn, flipping two more cards over. If the two cards don't match, the player flips them back over in the same spot and it's the next player's turn.

How to win

Once all matches have been made, each player counts their cards. The player with the most cards wins.

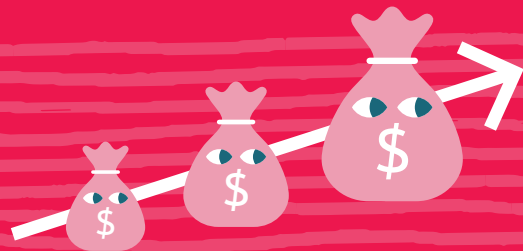
